About the Program

The program commences in March and has a duration of 0.5-1 year. Appropriate extension of the program can be applied under specific circumstances. Students will be granted a GXNU course-completion certificate if they finish courses in Chinese language study or the other majors as required for a specific academic year and succeed in exams.



About Guangxi Normal University

Guangxi Normal University is located in Guilin, a world-famous tourist city with a long history and ancient culture. Situated in Guangxi Zhuang Autonomous Region in the southern part of China, Guilin is “renowned for its unique beauty of mountains and rivers”.

Guangxi Normal University, founded in 1932, is a key university in Guangxi Zhuang Autonomous Region. It is now co-funded by the Ministry of Education and Guangxi provincial government. It consists of 21 schools and colleges. Currently, it has 2400 faculty members and staff, 27,000 undergraduate students, 6,500 graduate students, 260 PhD candidates, over 1,700 international students under various programs, and more than 20,000 adult education students. The university has 3 campuses - Wangcheng Campus, Yucui Campus, and Yanshan Campus - covering a total area of 270 hectares. Of them, Wangcheng Campus is known to be one of the most beautiful campuses in China and the only educational campus in the country cited as a 5-A tourist spot.

Guangxi Normal University offers Chinese courses ranging from short-term training to undergraduate, Master’s, and Doctoral degrees. The university offers 80 Bachelor degree programs, 18 Professional Master’s degree programs, 30 Master’s degree programs, 6 Doctoral degree programs, 3 post-doctoral research mobile stations, and has 6 first-class disciplines in Guangxi. Guangxi Normal University has been enjoying a fantastic reputation and influence on the global stage. It has established cooperative partnerships with over 200 universities and institutions of higher learning in more than 20 countries and regions. In the past 10 years or so, it has increasingly expanded its enrollment of international students, so far having received more than 15,000 short-term and long-term international students from more than 80 countries and regions. It has the authority to receive international students under the “Chinese Government Scholarship” awarded by China’s Ministry of Education, the “International Chinese Language Teachers Scholarship” by the Center for Language Education and Cooperation, and “ASEAN Scholarship” by the Guangxi Government. It is worth mentioning that Guangxi Normal University is the only university in Guangxi to have been approved by China’s Ministry of Education to be a Demonstration Base for foreigners studying in China, and has been approved by the Overseas Chinese Affairs Office under the State Council to be a national Chinese language education base. In 2018, Guangxi Normal University passed the National Quality Certification of Studying in China. Diplomas and degrees awarded by the university enjoy good reputations and are well recognized by educational institutions from around the world.

Application Qualifications

Applicant should:

1. Be a senior high school graduate and should be at least 18 (Before March 1, 2021);
2. Be a non-Chinese citizen and hold a valid ordinary passport;
3. Be physically and mentally healthy, meet the physical examination requirements for Chinese Visa or Residence Permit applicants in China and the physical examination requirements of the major to study in BFSU to ensure normal study and life in China;
4. Have no violation of disciplines, no records of public security punishment or of criminal conduct; be friendly to China and behave well; comply with Chinese laws and university regulations, and respect Chinese customs and manners;
5. Have a valid transfer certificate if transferring from another domestic university.

PLEASE NOTE: Applicants with zero basic Chinese language proficiency can also apply.

Application Procedures

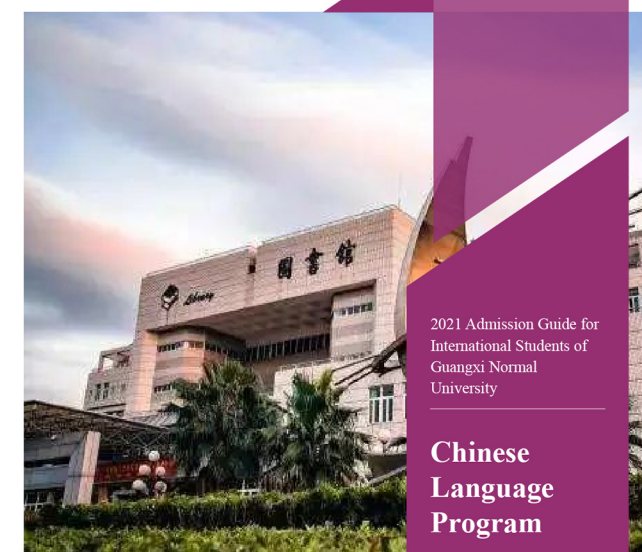
- 1.Website Application: The applicants can log into <http://gxnu.liuguanbao.com/Account/Login/> for registration.
- 2.E-mail Application: Applicants may also send an electronic version of the scanned materials to the admission office with a subject named “name + language student of the spring semester of 2021. The address is admissn@gxnu.edu.cn

Admission Procedures

Applicants who succeed in both the application document review and the exams/assessment will be selected, for whom GXNU will issue admission letters as well as, depending on the duration of the program applied, issue relevant admissions documents including the “Form of Visa Application for Study in China (JW202 Form)”. It takes about 4-5 weeks to mail out the relevant materials from the date of completion of the admissions process.
